DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Hole was spudded at 7:00 P. M. October 25, 1956 and was drilled to depth of 365 feet for casing point. 8-5/8" 20# casing was cemented at depth of 365 feet with 250 sacks on October 26, 1956. Plug was pumped down at 1:00 P. M. Cement was circulated back into cellar.

Cement will be allowed approximately 30 hours set time before being drilled from casing. Approximately 10 feet of cement was left in casin.
