Re: Request for Extension of Administrative
Order NFO-412 Regarding Flaring of Gas
in Eumont Pool, Lea County, New Mexico

Gentlemen:

Amerada Petroleum Corporation hereby requests that Administrative Order NFO-412 granting permission to flare gas from the Amerada State WE"1"-32 No. 1 located in the SE/4 of the SE/4 of Section 32, Township 20 South, Range 36 East, in the Eumont Gas Pool, Lea County, New Mexico, be extended indefinitely. The following reasons are given in support of this request.

- (1) Since the granting of the above order on June 23, 1958 gas production on the State WE"1"-32 No. 1 has declined. At the present time, approximately 4200 cubic feet per day of casing head gas is being produced by the well. Only approximately 200 cubic feet per day is being vented with the remainder used to operate lease equipment.
- (2) Oil production on this well is down to approximately 2 barrels oil per day and it is very possible that in the near future the well will have to be abandoned.
- (3) The nearest casing head gas gathering line is 5500' from the subject well. The operator of this gas line has not indicated any interest in laying a gathering line to the subject well.

Because of the facts stated above, Amerada Petroleum Corporation respectfully requests that Administrative Order NFO-412 be extended indefinitely or until such time as the well is abandoned or worked over.
