Pursuant to Rule 3 of Order No. R-520, Aztec Oil & Gas Company hereby submits its application for an exception to the well location regulations of Rule 2 of Order No. R-520, and it requests approval of a non-standard location of its natural gas well known as the State E-33 #2 well which is located on the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 33, Township 20 South, Range 36 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico.
