This well is completed in the Yates-7-Rivers-Queen pay through perforations 3834-3848' and 3854-3870'. Remedial work was done on July 15, 1961 and reported on Sundry Notice dated September 21, 1961. Prior to workover well averaged 4 BOPD. All of lost oil was recovered on November 24, 1961. Since recovery of lost oil, well has averaged 10 BOPD, no water.
