Dear Mr. Deck:

The recently submitted Form C-116 for your Seale Federal No. 4 located in Unit N of Section 34, T-20-S, R-36-E, Eumont Pool, indicated the gas-oil ratio to be 380,000 cubic feet of gas to 1 barrel of oil. The well will, therefore, be reclassified as a gas well in the Eumont Pool.

You are directed to shut in the well until a gas allowable can be assigned. Prior to assigning the gas allowable we must have notification from the gas transporter that the gas is being separately metered.

Our file for this well shows the gas purchaser to be Phillips Petroleum Company. If this reclassification from oil to gas causes a change of transporter to occur, then please file Form C-104 designating the transporter.

The recently submitted Form O-116 for your Santa Fe State No. 4 located in Unit 1 of Section 34, T-28-S, R-38-E, Mount Pool, National Petroleum Agency, Santa Fe, New Mexico, which is a gas well, is being reviewed. The well will, therefore, be reclassified as a gas well in the Mount Pool.

You are directed to shut in the well until a gas allowance can be assigned. Prior to assigning the gas allowance we must have notification from the gas transporter that the gas is being separately marketed.
