The Atlantic Refining Company respectfully requests administrative approval under provisions of Rule 5 (b) of 194038 Order No. 2-510 for a non-standard gas production unit for one well (vertical) No. 4 Well, located 330' from the south line and 1652' from the west line of Section 34, T-20S, R-16E, Dumont Pool, Lea County, New Mexico. The proposed non-standard gas production unit as so consist of 80-acres comprising the 3/4 E 1/4 of the above described section. Upon approval of this non-standard unit, it is requested that the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission Administrative Order NCP-421, dated November 30, 1955, covering the 3/4 E 1/4 of Section 34, T-20S, R-16E, Lea County, New Mexico, be cancelled.
