Administrative Order NFO-201

Gentlemen:

This is to correct Administrative Order NFO-201 dated May 6, 1955.

Reference is made to your application for permission to flare or vent gas from your Ida White Well No. 2, located in the NW/4 SW/4 of Section 35, Township 20 South, Range 36 East, Lea County, New Mexico, in the Eumont Gas Pool.

By authority granted me under provisions of paragraph (10) of Order R-520, as amended by Order R-553, you are hereby authorized to flare gas from the above described well.

Under the provisions of Order R-553 you must file Form C-110 in quadruplicate with the Hobbs office of this Commission (Box 2045), showing thereon that the gas is being vented or flared. In the future if you secure a connection for your gas, you must file an amended C-110 showing the applicable information. If you have not filed Form C-110, please do so immediately in compliance with the rule.

At some future date the Commission may request that you furnish this office with a progress report of your efforts to eliminate the venting or flaring of gas from the above described well, said Order to be effective as of May 6, 1955.
