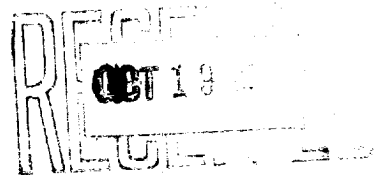

REPORT OF THE COMMITTEE ON THE REVISION OF THE CURRICULUM

RECOMMENDATIONS FOR THE REVISION OF THE CURRICULUM

The committee has considered the proposals for the revision of the curriculum and has concluded that the following changes are recommended:

- 1. The requirement for a second semester of general chemistry should be maintained.
- 2. The requirement for a second semester of organic chemistry should be maintained.
- 3. The requirement for a second semester of physical chemistry should be maintained.
- 4. The requirement for a second semester of biochemistry should be maintained.
- 5. The requirement for a second semester of inorganic chemistry should be maintained.
- 6. The requirement for a second semester of analytical chemistry should be maintained.
- 7. The requirement for a second semester of polymer chemistry should be maintained.
- 8. The requirement for a second semester of environmental chemistry should be maintained.
- 9. The requirement for a second semester of materials chemistry should be maintained.
- 10. The requirement for a second semester of nuclear chemistry should be maintained.
