Gentlemen:

Gulf Oil Corporation hereby makes application for approval of a non-standard gas proration unit in the Eumont Gas Pool comprising the W/2 of Section 36, T-20-S, R-36-E, Lea County, New Mexico, and in support thereof states the following facts:

- (1) Gulf Oil Corporation is owner and operator of an oil and gas lease known as its R. R. Bell (NCT-F) Lease, a portion of which is described above.
- (2) The R. R. Bell (NCT-F) #2, located 1980 feet from the South and West lines, Section 36, T-20-S, R-36-E, Lea County, New Mexico, was completed April 30, 1937, in the Eunice Oil Pool between 3705 feet and 3848 feet. On April 26, 1954, Commission Order DC-92 was issued approving the dual completing of this well in the Eumont Gas Pool. The well was dually completed on August 8, 1955, between 3470 feet and 3676 feet in the Eumont and produced 4400 MCF per day of gas with a back pressure of 740 psi. The applicant proposes to use this well as the unit well.
- (3) The proposed non-standard gas proration unit will meet the requirements of Rule 5(b) of the Oil Conservation Commission Order No. R-520 as follows:
  - (a) Contiguous quarter-quarter sections will comprise the unit.
  - (b) The proposed unit lies wholly within a single governmental section.
