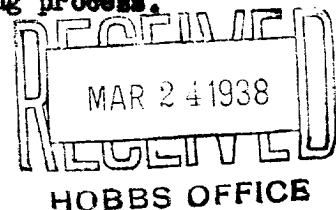

March 19th 1938 the **7 5/8" 8 thread 26.4#** New South Chester lapweld casing was cemented Anhydrite at 1206' 6", cemented with 600 sacks 2% aquagel cement and 10 sacks neat cement. Cement circulated in cellar, by Halliburton cementing process.

Propose to drill plug and test at **2 PM March 21st., 1938.**
