### FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK (FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS)

**TD-7448' PB-3150'**  
**9 5/8" casing set at 3170'**

This well is presently shut in as a non commercial gas well. In order to place well on commercial status, we desire to kill well with salt water and pull tubing; drill out cement plug to 4050' (DF) and spot 20 sacks cement plug from 4050'-4000', run a string of 5 1/2" OD 14# J-55 casing set at approximately 4000' and cement with 200 sacks (50 sacks neat cement and 150 sacks 4% gel cement). We desire to perforate the 5 1/2" casing from 3850'-3930' with 4 shots per foot; run tubing and wash perforations with 500 gals. of mud acid and fracture perforations with 20,000 gals. lease crude carrying 1 lb. of sand per gallon.
