


2. Said unit lies wholly within a single governmental section.
3. The entire proposed gas unit may be reasonably presumed to be productive of gas.
4. The length or width of said unit does not exceed 5,280 feet.
5. Copies of this application have been furnished this date by registered mail to all offset operators and all operators within 1,500 feet of said well as required by the provisions of said Rule 5 (b).

A plat is attached hereto showing to the best of Applicant's knowledge and belief the proposed unit, the location of the No. 1 well, and all offset wells and ownership thereof.

The granting of this application is in the interest of preventing waste and the protection of correlative rights.


In view of the facts set out herein it is respectfully requested that the Commission enter an order approving the proposed dual completion and non-standard proration unit both as prescribed above.
