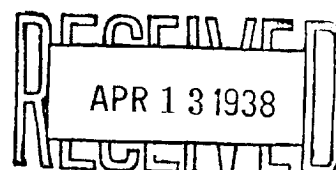

Acidized March 25th 1938 with 2,000 gallons.

Production before acid:- averaged 58 barrels oil per day and no water for
last 8 days previous to acidizing.

Production after acid:- 46 barrels in 24 hours flowing thru 1/2" and 3/4" chokes
Cutting 3% Acid and 2% Water, gas very small.
