Gentlemen:

Gulf Oil Corporation hereby makes application for approval of a 160-acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Monument Gas Pool, comprising the NE/4 of Section 7, T-19-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico, and in support thereof states the following facts:

- (1) Gulf Oil Corporation is owner and operator of an oil and gas lease known as its Elbert Shipp "B" Lease, a portion of which is located in the NE/4 of Section 7, T-19-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico.
- (2) On December 19, 1955, Gulf filed an application to dually complete the Elbert Shipp "B" Well No. 3 in the Monument Oil Pool from 3,900 feet to 4,050 feet and in the Monument Gas Pool from 3,450 feet to 3,700 feet. A production packer is to be set at approximately 3,850 feet. The subject well is located 660 feet from the East Line and 1,980 feet from the North Line of Section 7, T-19-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico. The applicant proposes to use this as the unit well. - (3) Prior to the application to dually complete the Elbert Shipp #3, the Oil Conservation Commission has authorized by Order R-717, a 320-acre non-standard proration unit comprising the NE/4 of Section 7 and the NE/4 of Section 8, T-19-S, R-37-E. The Elbert Shipp "B" Well #2 was designated as the unit well. This non-standard proration unit was cancelled by the Commission on January 29, 1956, at Gulf's request.

- (1) Gulf Oil Corporation is owner and operator of an oil and gas lease known as the "Libert Ship" No. 2, a portion of which is located in the NW 1/4 of Section 7, T-19-S, R-37-E, Lee County, New Mexico.
- (2) On December 19, 1955, Gulf filed an application to drill and complete the "Libert Ship" No. 2 in the Monument Gas Pool from 3,900 feet to 4,050 feet and in the Monument Gas Pool from 3,450 feet to 3,700 feet. A production packer is to be set at approximately 3,850 feet. The sub-lease well is located 660 feet from the East line and 1,980 feet from the North line of Section 7, T-19-S, R-37-E, Lee County, New Mexico. The applicant proposes to use this as the unit well.
- (3) Prior to the application to drill and complete the "Libert Ship" No. 2, the Oil Conservation Commission has authorized by Order R-77-E, 320-acre non-standard production unit comprising the NW 1/4 of Section 7 and the NW 1/4 of Section 8, T-19-S, R-37-E, Lee County, New Mexico. This non-standard production unit was cancelled by the Commission on January 29, 1956, at Gulf's request.
