
John M. Kelly respectfully requests that the Oil Conservation Commission grant an exception to Order R-553, No Flare Order, as it pertains to John M. Kelly's Conoco State #1, Section 7, T-19-S, R-37-E, Monument Pool, and in support thereof, state the following facts:

The Conoco State #1 is located 2510 feet from the South and East lines of Section 7, T-19-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico, and was completed on March 1, 1958, as an oil well in the Monument Pool. The well produces at a rate of 15 BOPD and 75 MCF of gas per day or a gas oil ratio of 5000 cubic feet per barrel.

Attached hereto is a plat indicating, well location, offset ownership, and location of tank battery. The nearest gas connection is on the Continental Oil State A-7 Lease approximately 1000 feet distance, a Warren Petroleum Line. Warren Petroleum Corporation advised us that they would connect the Conoco State #1, about July 1, 1958.

In view of the foregoing, it is requested that the Oil Conservation Commission issue a temporary exception to its Order R-553, for the Conoco State #1. We will inform you by means of a form C-110 when a casing head gas connection is obtained for this well.
