DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Pulled tubing, dumped 15 gallons Calseal from 4040' to 4021'. Dumped 8 gallons of hydromite from 4021' to 4012'. Ran 128 joints of 2-3/8" tubing, perforations at 4004'. Acidized w/3000 gallons 15% NE Acid by Chemical Process thru tubing. Average injection rate 72 GPM. TP 750-1000#. CP 500-900#. Flushed w/18 bbls oil.

RESULTS: Swabbed and flowed 20 bbls oil & 45 bbls acid water in 2 1/2 hrs. Well KO & flowed 50 bbls oil & 16 bbls acid water in 1 1/2 hrs. Flowed 46 bbls oil, no water thru tubing 1/2" choke in 12 hours. Formation gas volume 6000 cu.ft. GOR 65/l. TP 195#. Daily average production for March 1953 5 bbls oil & 2 bbls water. & Allowable before workover 45 bopd. Allowable after workover 45 bopd.
