gentlemen:

Gulf Oil Corporation hereby makes application for approval of a non-standard gas production unit comprising the  $\frac{1}{4}$  and  $\frac{1}{2}$  of  $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 16, T19S, R37E, Lea County, New Mexico, and in support thereof states the following facts:

- (1) Gulf Oil Corporation is the owner and operator of an oil and gas lease known as the Lee-State "X" Lease which comprises the 240 acres above described.
- (2) The Lee-State "X" is located 60 feet from the west line and 660 feet from the north line, Section 16, T19S, R37E, Lea County, New Mexico, was completed August 25, 1954, at a depth of 3,550 feet as a gas well in the Zunmat Gas Pool. The applicant proposes to use this well as the unit well.
- (3) The proposed non-standard gas production unit will meet the requirements of Rule 5(b) of the Oil Conservation Commission Order No. 4-520 as follows:
  - (a) Contiguous quarter-quarter sections will comprise the unit.
  - (b) The proposed unit lies wholly within a single governmental section.
  - (c) All acreage within the proposed unit may reasonably be presumed productive of gas.
