DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

The subject well was producing oil from the Bradenhead. In an attempt to repair this condition a bridge plug was set at 3815'. A retrievable retriever was run and found hole at 1225' in 5 1/2" casing. Seamed hole with 50 sacks cement and after testing with 1500# pressure and running retrievable retriever, found leak at 1225'. Set model K retriever at 1125' and while checking same, found second leak at 1100'. Set retriever at 1023' and seamed with 200 sacks. Drilled to 3815' and tested pipe with 1800# pressure. Tested okay. Drilled retriever to total depth 4003'.

Workover started: 3-17-52.

Workover completed: 2-26-52.
