Before workover the well was shut-in, 5 1/2" casing set at 3333' leaving 194' of open hole in the Grayburg pay. T.D. 4027'.
A hydronite plug was set at 4002' and 95% water was snabbed. After plugback to 3992' with hydronite plug, snabbed 100% water. After plugback to 3945', unable to shut off water. Well was not treated.
After workover T.D. 4027', PR 3945', Grayburg pay 3833-3945' open hole. The job was unsuccessful and the well is shut-in. Workover started 5-23-56. Workover completed 5-31-56.
