NOTICE OF INTENTION TO TEST WATER SHUT-OFF

Notice must be given to the State Geologist or to the proper Oil and Gas Inspector at least five days before the test. It is desirable that a representative of the Department of the State Geologist witness the water shut-off before drilling into the productive sand whenever possible. If changes in the proposed plan are considered advisable, a copy of this notice showing such changes will be returned to sender. Submit this notice in triplicate.

You are hereby notified that we intend to test the shut-off of water in State-G  
Well No. 1 in SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec. 18, T. 19 - S, R. 37 - E  
N. M. P. M., Monument Oil Field Lea County,  
on August 27, 1935 9-5/8" in 36 lb. casing was { cemented } in Anhydrite  
formation at a depth of 2510' feet on August 24, 1935  
500 sacks of El Toro cement were used.

The method used in placing the cement was as follows: Halliburton

Casing and fittings will be tested by building up 1200# pressure and allowing it to stand undisturbed for thirty minutes. Cement will be drilled out of casing and the same test applied again for thirty minutes.
