Following is a report on the work done and the results obtained under the heading noted above at the Amerada Petroleum Corporation, State of Lease Well No. 1 in the Company or Operator of Sec. 18, T. 10-S, R. 37-E N. M. P. M., SW 1/4 of SW 1/4 Monument Oil Field, Lea County.

## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

The above described well was treated with 500 gallons of Chemical Process Acid on September 21, 1935 and allowed to set 6 hours. All acid was swabbed from the well and well was retreated with 3000 gallons of Chemical Process Acid, which was allowed to set 6 hours. As a result of the treatment the production was increased from 11 barrels of oil in three hours with 420,000 gas to 309 barrels of oil in 4½ hours with 890,000 gas.

Notice of intention to do this work was not sent in as it was part of completion of well.
