Rigged up Halliburton and Sand-Oiled thru casing perforations from 3510' to 3530'; 3542' to 3554'; and 3562' to 3655' w/10,000 Gal. oil and 10,000# sand. Sand oil treatment increased the gas potential from 2,300,000 CFPPD to 7,700,000CFPPD.
