Gentlemen:

Gulf Oil Corporation hereby makes application for approval of a non-standard gas proration unit comprising the S/2 of N/2 Section 18, T-19-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico, and in support thereof states the following facts:

- (1) Gulf Oil Corporation is owner and operator of an oil and gas lease known as the F. W. Kutter "C" Lease which comprises the 160 acres above described.
- (2) The F. W. Kutter "C" #1 located 1960 feet from the North line and 660 feet from the East line, Section 18, T19S, R37E, Lea County, New Mexico, was completed April 18, 1937, at a depth of 4026 feet in the Monument Oil Pool, and on February 17, 1955, Gulf filed an application to dually complete this well between 3520 feet and 3640 feet in the Bumet Gas Pool. The Applicant proposes to use this well as the unit well.
- (3) The proposed non-standard gas proration unit will meet the requirements of Rule 5(b) of the Oil Conservation Commission Order No. R-520 as follows:
 - (a) Contiguous quarter-quarter sections will comprise the unit.
 - (b) The proposed unit lies wholly within a single governmental section.
 - (c) All acreage within the proposed unit may reasonably be presumed productive of gas.

12, T12N, R12E, Sec 12, T12N, R12E, and in support thereof
states the following facts:

- (1) Gulf Oil Corporation is owner in fee simple of an oil and
gas lease known as the S/2 of S/4 Section 12, T12N, R12E, Sec 12,
T12N, R12E, which covers the 100 acres above described.
- (2) The S/2 of S/4 Section 12, T12N, R12E, Sec 12, T12N, R12E,
line and 600 feet from the east line, Section 12, T12N, R12E,
1937, Sec 12, T12N, R12E, was completed April 18,
1937, at a depth of 4036 feet in the Monumental well,
and on February 17, 1955, Gulf Oil Corporation applied for
approval to complete this well between 3500 feet and 4040 feet
in the same gas pool. The applicant proposes to use
this well as the test well.
- (3) The proposed non-standard gas promotion unit will meet the
requirements of Rule 5(a) of the Oil Conservation Commission
Order No. 1-320 as follows:
 - (a) Contiguous quarter-quarter sections will comprise the
unit.
 - (b) The proposed unit lies wholly within a single govern-
mental section.
 - (c) The average depth of the proposed unit is reasonably
be presumed, exclusive of gas.
