Following is a report on the work done and the results obtained under the heading noted above at the THE TEXAS COMPANY'S American National Insurance Co. Well No. 1 in the NE 1/4 of NW 1/4 of Sec. 18, T. 19-S, R. 37-E, N. M. P. M., Monument Field, Lea County.

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Total Depth 4029', plugged back from 4040' - Lime. 7" casing cemented @ 3825' with 300 sacks. Well was cleaned out to bottom 4040', and plugged back to 4029' with 4 sacks of cement. Acidized 6-11-46 below packer @ 3996' to 4029', using 8 gallons Jelseal blanket on bottom. Before acidizing, well averaged approximately 15 barrels oil and 1 barrel water per day. After acidizing, well pumped 33.4 barrels oil and 1.6 barrels water in 24 hours, on test 10 days after acidizing.
