Reference is made to your letter dated September 18, 1957, above subject, whereby authority was granted The Texas Company to operate a 317-acre non-standard proration unit in the Eumont Gas Pool consisting of the N/2, Section 18, T-19-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico, contingent upon submission of proof of communitization to both your office and the Oil Conservation Commission's Hobbs office. Attached please find a copy of the necessary communitization agreement covering the Keohane Unit, which will henceforth be operated by The Texas Company. The 317 acres in this non-standard proration unit will be assigned to The Texas Company's Keohane Unit Well No. 1, located in the NE/4 NW/4, Section 18. This well previously had assigned to it only the N/2 of the N/2 of Section 18. A copy of this letter and the communitization agreement and three copies of Form C-128 covering this new acreage assignment are being submitted to your Hobbs office under separate cover.

Your consideration for immediate approval of the assignment of this 317 acres to Keohane Unit Well No. 1 for allowable purposes will be appreciated.
