 - (d) Neither the unit nor the width of the proposed unit exceeds 640 acres.
- Producers as covered by Paragraph 5, Rule 5(b) of R-520 are notified of this application by letter through registered mail, and a letter covering the granting of the proposed non-standard proration unit is requested from each.
