FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

At the present time the 7 wells on the B. V. Culp Lease are produced into two tank batteries consisting of 3 - 625 bbl. wood tanks each. The condition of this equipment is such that it is necessary to make replacement of the batteries. We propose to replace these batteries with one battery consisting of 4 - 500 bbl. steel tanks.

Permission is asked to produce the 7 wells on this lease into one centralized battery. Header and separators will be so placed that individual tests can be made on ~~individual~~ wells as necessary.
