Pulled tubing and reran with nine 2" EUE 10 thd. Meria Type BM 100# differential flow valves set at 976', 1228', 1481', 1730', 1982', 2237', 2485', 2738', and 2992'. Tubing was set at 3996'.

Production before -- Irregular, well died often on tubing.

Production after -- Well flowed 105 barrels of oil and no water in 24 hours through 1/2" choke 1 1/2 rounds open, casing pressure 480#.
