Exception to Rule 502 I (a)

Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for approval of an exception to paragraph (a) of Rule 502 I of the Commission's Rules and Regulations for your Graham State "D" Well No. 2, located in the SE/4 SE/4 of Section 19, Township 19 South, Range 37 East, Monument Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.

In view of the extenuating circumstances of your case with regard to the water production of said well, an exception should be granted. Therefore, by authority granted me under paragraph (b) of Rule 502 I of the Commission's Rules and Regulations, you are hereby authorized to flow your Graham State "D" Well No. 2 at a rate in excess of 125% of the top allowable for the Monument Pool.

It is understood that this exception is granted temporarily and in no case shall the production exceed the monthly tolerance as provided under Rule 502 II and that the Commission, at its discretion, may call upon you for a report on this well.

extra production of said well, an exception should be granted. Under the
provisions of paragraph (f) of Rule 505.1 of the Commission's Rules and Regulations,
you are hereby authorized to flow your well for a period of 120 days
at a rate in excess of 125% of the top allowable production rate.
During this period.

It is understood that this exception is granted temporarily and that if the
production exceeds the monthly tolerance as provided under paragraph (f) of
Rule 505.1, at its discretion, may call upon you for a reduction in
well.
