Our Land Office Well No. 1 is presently producing oil from the Grayburg formation having been completed in December, 1935. The 7 inch production casing is set at 3786 feet with 200 sacks of cement. The well is also cased with 259 feet of 13 3/8 inch surface pipe and 1313 feet of 9 5/8 inch casing. No remedial work has been performed on this well since completion. We propose dually completing this well by perforating in the Yates, Seven Rivers and Upper Queen sands as shown on the attached diagrammatic sketch.
