DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

T. D. 3990 Line. Killed well with Halliburton, using 21 sacks crushed Limestone, 5 sacks Aquagel & 1/2 bale Fibretex. Pulled tubing & measured up on bottom. No savings. Ran tubing with Robinson 3-in-1 formation packer set at 3649'. Treated formation below packer with 1000 gal. Dowell XX.

Before repairing this well it flowed 56.40 bbls. oil, 0 water thru 1/8" choke on 6 hr. test. Its average gas/oil ratio for April was 3776. After repairing well it flowed 221 bbls. oil, 0 water in 24 hours thru 3/8" & 1/16" choke with gas/oil ratio of 660. (5-10-38). On May 11th flowed 87 bbls. oil, 0 water in 24 hours thru 1/16" & 1/32" choke with gas/oil ratio of 690.
