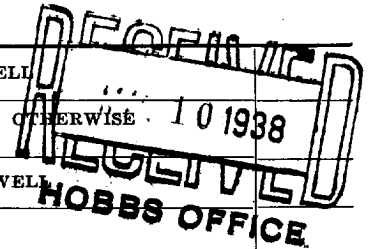

## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

T. D. 3990 Lime. Treated formation below formation packer set at 5949' with 1000 gal. Dowell "XX". Treated to T. D. thru perforations in tubing.

After swabbing twice, once to 2000' & once to bottom, well started flowing. After recovering oil load & acid, flowed 275 bbls. oil, cutting 1/2 of 1% water, in 18 hours. Gas measured 265,000 cu. ft. daily. Gas/oil ratio was 722.
