For the purpose of determining the relative values of the various grades of cotton, the Bureau has established a system of grading which is based on the following principles: (1) The quality of the cotton is determined by the length of the staple, the fineness of the staple, the strength of the staple, and the cleanliness of the staple. (2) The relative values of the various grades of cotton are determined by the relative values of these four factors.

The following table shows the relative values of the various grades of cotton as determined by the Bureau's system of grading:

Grade of Cotton Relative Value

1. Extra Long Staple 100

2. Long Staple 80

3. Medium Staple 60

4. Short Staple 40

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
