DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

This well was spudded at 6:00 pm 5-4-51. A 12-1/4" hole was drilled to 224' and 9-5/8" 36 lb. casing cemented at that depth with 150 sks. Cement was circulated to the surface. The plug was down at 1:00 pm 5-5-51. Cement was allowed to set 24 hours before resuming drilling operations and pressure testing the casing.
