- (7) The approval of this application for a 320-acre non-standard gas proration unit with the assignment of only a 120-acre allowable to Gulf's F. W. Kutter "B" No. 1 until such time as communitization is completed will, in the opinion of the applicant, prevent waste, protect correlative rights and serve the best interest of conservation.

In view of the existence of the facts herein stated and compliance with the provisions of Rule 5 (b) of the Oil Conservation Commission's Order No. R-520, Gulf Oil Corporation requests that the Secretary of the Commission approve the above described gas proration unit and issue an administrative order which will authorize the applicant to produce a 120-acre allowable in accordance with applicable pool rules until the date the communitization of the leases in the proposed 320-acre unit has been completed and the Commission authorizes the production of a 320-acre unit allowable.


