I propose to plug and abandon the well because it produces less than 1 BOPT and more water per day than a 1 1/2" pump will remove (over 100 EWPT). The productive zone was Grayburg formation. I propose to put cement plugs as follows: 3901' (top of cement plug now in casing) to 3850' (to cover all perforations), 2500' to 2400' (across the casing stub), 350' to 250' (across surface casing shoe), and 40' to 0' (surface plug).

Plugs will be by pump through tubing. Heavy mud will be placed by tubing between all plugs.

I plan to cut and pull about 2450' of 4 1/2" OD, J-55 casing. All the tubing, about 3890', will be pulled from hole. Tubing is 2 3/8", J-55.

Top of the well will be closed by cement, and appropriate sign will be erected to mark the site as required.

I expect the abandonment to be ready for inspection for approval by about March 29, 1968.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.

Item 1: Proposals to abandon a well and subsequent reports of abandonment should include such special information as is required by local Federal and/or State offices. In addition, each proposal and report should include reasons for the abandonment; data on any former or present productive zones, or other zones with present significant fluid content, not sealed off by cement or otherwise; depths (top and bottom) and method of placement of cement plugs; mud or other material placed below, between and above plugs; amount, size, method of parting of any casing, liner or tubing pulled and the depth to top of any left in the hole; method of closing top of well; and date well site conditioned for final inspection looking to approval of the abandonment.
