DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

This test was drilled to total depth of 4014' and found sulphur water on a drill stem test within the interval of 3970' to 4014'. We therefore have given up the idea of making an oil well in the San Andres and have plugged this water off with a cement plug of 100 sacks from 4014' back to 3708'. We propose to complete this well as a gas test between the bottom of the 8-5/8", cemented at 3539' and the plugged back depth of 3708'
