Following is a report on the work done and the results obtained under the heading noted above at the Southern Union Gas Company Burke Well No. 1 in the Lease Company or Operator of Sec. 28, T. 19S, R. 37E, N. M. P. M., Monument Field, Lea County.

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

We cemented 8-5/8" casing at 3539' with 1600 sacks on September 22, 1950. Plug was pumped down at 3:25 P.M. At 10:00 P.M., Sept 22, 1950 we ran a temperature survey and determined that cement had come up behind the 8-5/8" casing to a depth of 940' from the surface.

We allowed the cement a set time of 48 hours then went in hole with drill pipe and pressure tested casing with 1000# before drilling plug. Casing and cement job were both found to be O K.
