FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

With total depth of 3540' we have cemented 8-5/8" casing at 3539' with 1500 sacks (1500 sacks of 65 aquagel cement and 100 sacks neat cement). Plug was pumped down at 3:25 P.M. September 22, 1950. Halliburton temperature survey was run September 23, 1950 and top of cement, outside of 8-5/8" casing was found at 940 feet.

We will allow cement a set time of 48 hours before testing casing and drilling cement.
