DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Due to recent rig builders strike this hole was commenced with a Spudder. When derrick was completed and rotary tools could be rigged up, the hole was reamed and drilled to depth of 210' with diameter of 17 1/2". 186' of 13-3/8 48# casing was cemented at 199' with 175 sacks of regular cement. Cement circulated back into cellar when plug was pumped down at 10:00 P.M. September 12, 1950.

Hole was spudded September 8, 1950. We propose a cement time of 36 hours.
