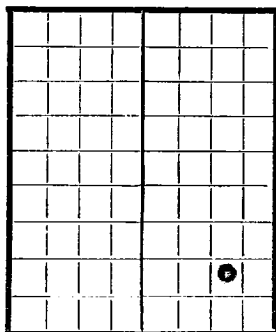

We propose to test the gas section below 3550' and complete therein if the oil pay is non-commercial.						

If changes in the above plan become advisable we will notify you before cementing or landing casing. We estimate that the first productive oil or gas sand should occur at a depth of about oil @ 3925 feet.

Additional information: \* We propose to set and cement the 9-5/8" at 3500' with a light amount of cement then drill to the oil zone at approximately 3925'. If this zone is dry we will plug it off then perforate the 9-5/8 in the Rustler anhydrite and squeeze with 100 sacks. If the oil zone is productive we will squeeze ~~as above before cementing 5 1/2"~~
