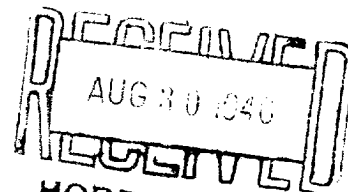

3948: Plugged back depth, swabbed 22 hours and swabbed 12.57 barrels of fresh water, and on August 28, 1946 Acidized with 2000 Gallons of Dowell XX Acid, Minimum Casing Pressure 300#, Tubing Pressure 450#, Maximum Casing Pressure 1500#, Tubing Pressure 1100#, At end of 23 barrels Oil Flush Casing 1400#, Tubing 1400#, Started at 2:07PM Finished at 3:50PM, Used 12 gallons of Jelly Seal on bottom, Swabbed 13 hours and swabbed 192.39 barrels oil and 31.10 barrels water.
