3948' Plugged back depth, Plugged back with 22½ Gallons Dowell K-45 & 50 Plastic and J-20 Filler in two stages, Ran steel line measurement and found top of plastic at 3948', Ran 2½" EUE 6.5# 10 V R-2, Seamless Steel Tubing with 6 5/8" x 2½" American Type G Control Packer, displace water with 120 barrels of oil and set Packer at 3780' and tubing set at 3941' with bottom joint perforated and bottom of joint bull nosed. Getting ready to swab.
