New 8 5/8" 28# Electric weld casing was set in this well at 2495' and cemented with 500 sacks of El Toro cement.

On April 30th. 1200# pump pressure will be applied to the casing and fittings and allowed to stand undisturbed for thirty minutes. The cement plug will then be drilled from inside the casing and the same test again applied and allowed to stand undisturbed for thirty minutes. If there is no drop in pressure, drilling will then be resumed.
