12 1/2" 40# New Casing was set in this well at 182' and cemented by the Halliburton method with 200 sacks of cement.

Cement plug was drilled out of casing and hole bailed to bottom, and left set one hour undisturbed. Bailer was again run to bottom to determine if any water had accumulated. No water had accumulated so drilling was resumed.
