2975' T. ^D - 8-5/8" OD Csg. set @ 2491' & 6-5/8" OD Csg. set @ 3860'. Well was originally completed April 15, 1936. Oil is being produced from Monument Pool & is currently carried @ 40 bbls per day on the State Proration Schedule. It is our intention to dual complete this well by perforating the 6-5/8" OD Csg from 3260' to 3380' and from 3412' to 3560' and produce gas through the casing from the Seven Rivers-Queen Section. We will continue to produce oil thru the tubing from the Monument Pool.
