**DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED**

8-5/8" 28# New Casing was set in this well at 2491' and cemented by the Halliburton method with 500 sacks of cement.

Casing and fittings were tested with 1200# pump pressure and allowed to stand for thirty minutes undisturbed. No drop in pressure resulted. Cement plug was then drilled out of casing and the same teste again applied and allowed to stand undisturbed for thirty minutes. No drop in pressure resulted. Drilling was resumed.
