## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

8-5/8" 28# 8-thd. New Electric Weld casing was set in this well and cemented by the Halliburton method with 500 sacks of cement. Pipe set at 2492'.

Casing and fittings were tested with 1200# pump pressure and allowed to stand undisturbed for thirty minutes. No drop in pressure resulted. Cement plug was then drilled out of casing and the same pressure again applied and allowed to stand undisturbed for thirty minutes. No drop in pressure resulted so Drilling was resumed.
