## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

**12 $\frac{1}{2}$ " 40#** New Casing was set in this well at 184' and cemented by the Halliburton method with 150 sacks of cement.

Cement plug was drilled out of casing and the hole bailed to bottom and allowed to stand undisturbed for one hour. Bailer was again run to bottom to determine if any water had accumulated. No water had accumulated so drilling was resumed.
