Dear David:

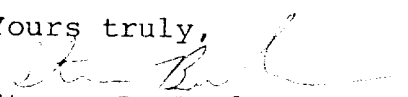
As I stated in our telephone conversation the other day, we would like to have administrative approval to commingle Langlie-Mattix gas and Jalmat gas on this lease. This approval would only be for the interim period (anywhere from six months to one year) while El Paso Natural Gas is getting us a meter run installed for the Langlie-Mattix portion of the gas from this lease. All gas from this lease is under common ownership.

We would set our own check meter at the tank battery between our separator and El Paso's existing meter run #61777, which is presently dedicated to the Shahan 33 #1 (Jalmat gas well). We wish to re-complete our Shahan 33 #3, and later the Shahan 33 #2, as Langlie-Mattix gas producers. This interim approval would greatly help us to take advantage of the winter spot market prices.

We have permanent releases of all our contracts covering this acreage from El Paso, therefore there is no conflict as far as they are concerned with different kinds of gas flowing through the same meter run.

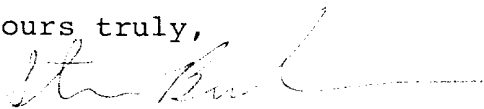
Dear Clovis:

We would like to request that you reactivate this meter run so we may put the gas from our Shahan 33 #3 into it. We will lay flow line to this meter run.
